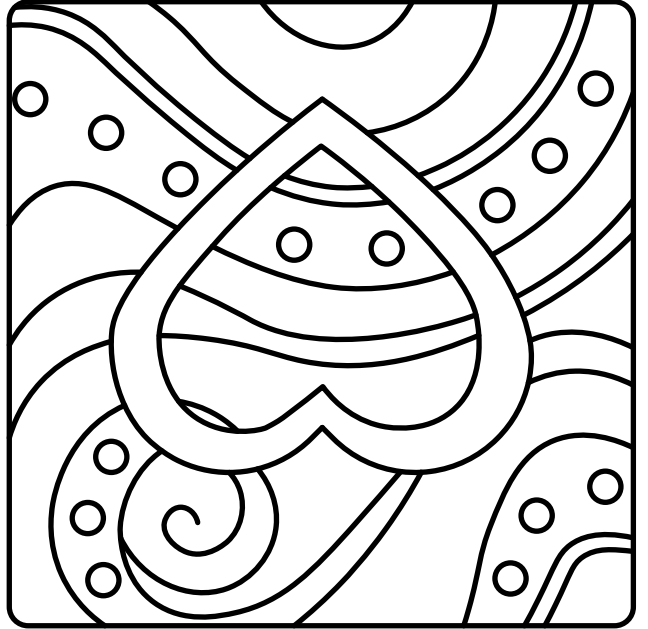
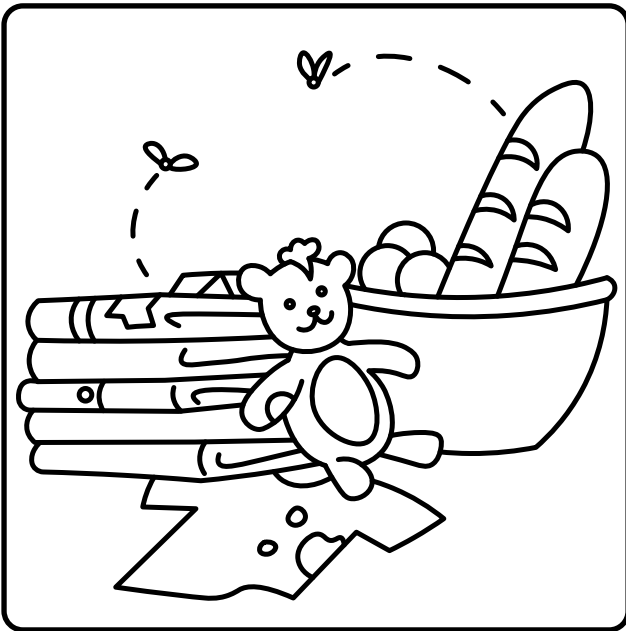
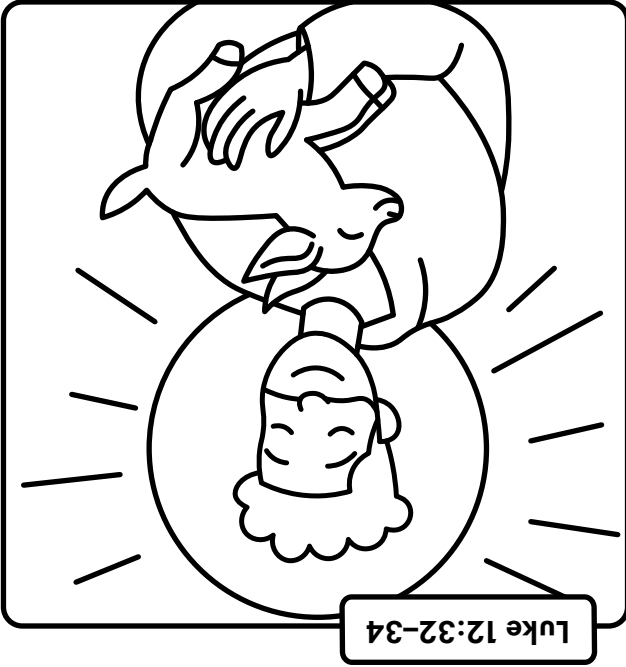


4. Jesus explained that if you want to know what is important to someone, look at their treasures. Our special treasures show what we truly value, or where our "heart" is.



3. Jesus tells the disciples to give their possessions to people who go without and make space for blessings that cannot be taken away or ruined. Be ready to receive the treasures of God's kingdom.

1. Sometimes the world feels like a scary place, but Jesus says to his disciples, "Don't be afraid, little flock." Jesus calls the people his "little flock" because we are like sheep, and he is a good shepherd.
